Appeal noun

A serious, urgent, or heartfelt request.

Branch out expression

To start to do something different from what you usually do.

Closure noun

A sense of resolution or conclusion.

Clustered adjective

Growing or situated in a group.

Enquire verb

Ask for information from someone.

Faithfully adverb

In a loyal manner.

Hostile adjective

Showing or feeling opposition or dislike; unfriendly.

Jargon noun

Special words or expressions used by a profession or group that are difficult for others to understand.

Merely adverb

Just; only.

Outlines noun

A general description or plan showing the essential features of something but not the detail.
