Accuracy noun

The quality or state of being correct or precise.

Assignments noun

A task or piece of work allocated to someone as part of a job or course of study.

Atmosphere noun

The pervading tone or mood of a place, situation, or creative work.

C-map noun

Concept maps are graphical tools for organizing and representing knowledge. They include concepts, usually enclosed in circles or boxes of some type, and relationships between concepts indicated by a connecting line linking two concepts..

Conversely adverb

Introducing a statement or idea which reverses one that has just been made or referred to.

Crowning verb

Declare or acknowledge (someone or something) as the best.

Crystalline adjective

Very clear.

Dragging on Phrasal verb

To continue for longer than you want or think is necessary.

Emphasize verb

Give special importance or value to (something) in speaking or writing.

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Encouragement

noun

The action of giving someone support, confidence, or hope.

Exerting

verb

Apply or bring to bear (a force, influence, or quality).

Extrinsic

adjective

Not part of the essential nature of someone or something;

Gag gifts

noun

Gifts given strictly for comedic effect.

Holistic

adjective

Characterized by the belief that the parts of something are intimately interconnected and explicable only by reference to the whole.

Hone

verb

Refine or perfect (something) over a period of time.

Intrinsic

adjective

Belonging naturally; essential.

Loaf

noun

A quantity of bread that is shaped and baked in one piece and usually sliced before being eaten.

Matrix

noun

The cultural, social, or political environment in which something develops.

Monotony

noun

Lack of variety and interest; tedious repetition and routine.

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Ownership noun

The act, state, or right of possessing something.

Procrastinate verb

Delay or postpone action; put off doing something.

Prominent adjective

Important; famous.

Quotation noun

A group of words taken from a text or speech and repeated by someone other than the original author or speaker.

Regardless noun

Despite the circumstances.

Self-regulates noun

Control by oneself or itself, as in an economy, business organization, etc., especially such control as exercised independently of governmental supervision, laws, or the like.

Skimming noun

Read (something) quickly so as to note only the important points.

Strategy noun

A plan of action designed to achieve a long-term or overall aim.

Struggle verb

Make forceful or violent efforts to get free of restraint or constriction.
